## 2017 Membership Agreement

*The mission of the Latino Health Council (LHC) is to promote and support the health and wellbeing of the Latino community through education, advocacy, consulting, and networking.*

### **Membership is open to:**

Organizations that are committed to the LHC mission and provide a representative on their behalf. New members should be sponsored by a current member.

### **Membership fee:**

Our annual membership fee is

- \$100 for organizations with 50 employees or more
- \$50 for organizations with 49 employees or less
- \$25 for individuals

Payments should be mailed to **Latino Health Council, PO Box 731 Madison, WI 53701** by March 1 of every year.

*Note: If the membership fee presents a hardship for your organization, please contact the LHC co-chairs.*

### **Responsibilities:**

- Regular attendance – attend 8 meetings/year. If possible, you may send another representative if you're not able to attend a meeting. If you wish to invite a guest to attend with you, please ask the LHC Executive Committee for approval beforehand.
- Volunteer annually at LHC sponsored events, e.g. Latino Health Fair.
- Serve as liaison with the organization/institution you represent.
- Take minutes at a meeting once yearly.\*

- Host a meeting and/or present at a meeting once yearly. You may use a location other than your organization, if necessary. Hosting requires that you provide a light breakfast and beverages for the meeting. You may also choose to do a short presentation about your organization.\*
- Sit on a LHC sub-committee.

\*Please note that due to the size of the council and the number of monthly meetings, not all members will take minutes or host a meeting every year.

**Benefits:**

- Voting rights
- Official member of LHC
  - Information about your organization on the LHC website, including a link to your site
  - Participation in the LHC listserv
- Opportunity to promote your organization
  - Share what you are doing with all members of the LHC (in person and on the listserv)
  - Get feedback/input from members of LHC
- Collaboration with fellow members/networking
- Outreach Opportunities
  - Guest on Nuestra Salud radio show (if relevant topic)
  - Tabling/presenting at events within the Latino Community
  - Website visibility
- Partnership with an organization that demonstrates leadership and expertise within the Latino community and the community at large.
